



Floresti

Floresti is beautifully set among wooded hills, close to Malancrav. It is a small village only 70 houses and 140 inhabitants, the village had been scheduled for “rural systemisation” (i.e. being bulldozed over) during Ceausescu’s regime. Luckily, the 1989 Revolution put a stop to that plan.

The 15th century Saxon church contains a plaque commemorating a member of the Transylvanian Bethlen family. The remains of the old altar (1550) can be seen in the Sighisoara Museum.



In the village a traditional barrel maker is willing to share his craft with visitors. Why not order a small handmade barrel with your own design carved into it. A unique gift or the perfect thing to keep your plum brandy in at home.

There are beautiful walks to Malancrav and Cris along the Tarnava Mare Long Distance Walking Route. Local guesthouse accommodation can be booked in the village.

Floresti is reached by turning off the DN14 at Laslea and following the signs.
